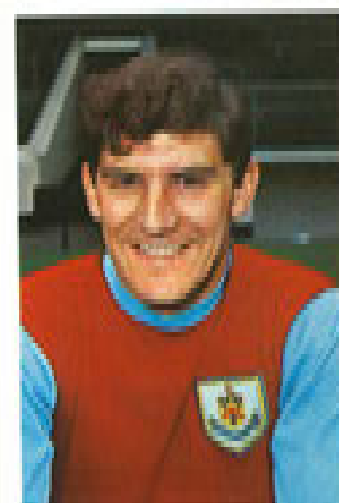
FRANK CASPER
